Trade Offs to Consider

-  Requires manual cleaning and careful handling
-  Not suitable for frequent or high-volume use
-  Limited capacity for multiple servings
-  Does not include a built-in thermometer
-  Heavier than portable coffee makers
-  Not ideal for daily use in a busy kitchen
